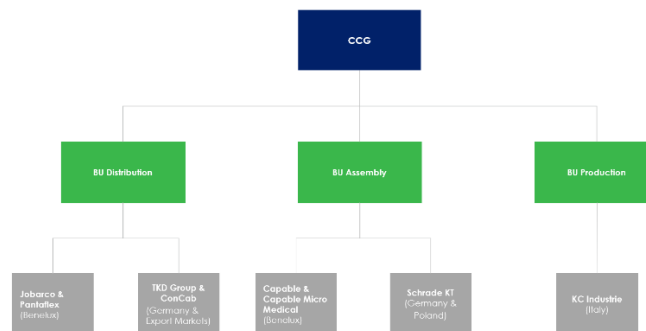


**Company profile Cable Connectivity Group and Schrade Kabeltechnik GmbH**
